POWER TO THE GROUND

As one season ends and we head into a new dairy season it is a good time to reflect on some of the newsworthy items centred on Nitrosol's primary interest – healthy soils.

Water quality was a big issue and is likely to continue and become an election issue. Many farmers are spending a lot of money to address the issue of nitrate leaching into our waterways, riparian planting, fencing waterways, reducing cow numbers, considering herd homes, extensive effluent systems and a variety of accords and programmes. However, as Graham Shepherd discusses in a recent article in NZ Farmer are we addressing the real issue of applying too much nitrogen fertiliser?

Nitrogen fertiliser use has increased dramatically since 1983 shortly after the opening of the Kapuni urea plant in 1982. An estimated 750 000 tons was used in 2014, mostly on dairy farms, a 3750% increase from 1983. Another estimate by the Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment showed urea use climbing 162% from 1996 to 2002 while milks solids per hectare only increased 34%. Some of the increase in milk solids is breeding and some will be more grass from fertiliser. However, the production response to the application of fertiliser doesn't look that flash - poor nitrogen use efficiency. How many times though do we hear the argument from those who promote the use of urea that it is not the fertiliser to blame but the cows pee? It is all the nitrogen in the cows' pee that causes the problem, too much nitrogen for the grass to use, patches of grass the cows won't eat. How did the extra nitrogen get into the urine? From the high nitrogen levels in the grass? The loading per hectare of urine is from more cows per hectare only made possible by use of chemical nitrogen. Don't blame the cows blame the system.

To fix the damage to our waterways requires a mind-set shift and a focus away from NPK (Nitrogen, Phosphate, Potassium) to BFP (Bacteria, Fungi, Protozoa). Taking care of the livestock in your soil, the soil biology and the basis of biological farming, not only takes care of waterways but your livestock above ground too. The cows are happier with carbohydrate rich, nutrient dense grass that tastes good and produces milk. Over time nitrogen is fixed by bacteria for free reducing costs and increasing your bank balance.

On the subject of your bank balance, I had the opportunity to talk recently to a long-time customer of Nitrosol who came to the factory in Auckland to pick up a 1000L IBC of Oceanic for his beef farm. Being a relative newcomer to Nitrosol I am always interested in talking to long time users and their experiences. This customer had once been a dairy farmer in the Clevedon district and used Nitrosol on his dairy farm.

This was before the current focus on water quality, nitrate leaching, Overseer etc. so I was keen to understand why he was one of the very early adopters. When asked it was quite simply - Nitrosol doubled his production and was a no brainer financially.

Excess use of nitrogen has another unintended consequence on soil health. Bacteria with a feed of nitrogen need to consume carbon to maintain their unique nitrogen to carbon ratio. This carbon comes from the soil and thus we reduce our soil carbon content. Soil carbon or humus is a major source of nutrient and water holding capacity. Together with BFP constitutes a good porous, healthy soil.

This brings me to another issue we faced recently, large scale flooding. Sure, the rain was excessive but how much can we discount the impact of soils made hard and incapable of absorbing the water by excessive use of chemical fertilisers in particular nitrogen? Demonstrations on YouTube (search for, GFE 2016 – Ray Archuletta “It starts with the soil” about 14 minutes in the video) show the difference in water holding capability between healthy biological soils and soils with damaged structure. With healthy biological soils could more water have been absorbed and the flooding averted?

Healthy biological soils hold together as the glomalin, a type of soil glue produced by fungi, creates stable macro aggregates. We know that P fixes to soil particles and P is lost from our farms through soil erosion and ends up in waterways this way. If we moderate our use of nitrogen and develop healthy soils focussing on BFP we also look after our P better. Excess P in itself is bad as it suppresses mycorrhizal fungi, K, Fe, Zn, Cu and Se all of these are needed for healthy soils and animals. It is all about balance with a single “L”.

Nitrosol with a NPK of 836 and a raft of trace elements plus other simple and complex carbohydrates in the formulation is the start for a biological soil. The many detractors will say - “look at the nutrient levels they are not high enough to do anything”. A new system requires a new way of thinking. Forget the NPK and look at the BFP. It's all about the balance between the nutrients, the carbon source supplied with the nitrogen, the amino acids as part of the formulation, feeding the plants a balanced diet to stimulate photosynthesis and providing bacteria and fungi a food source to re-activate them. Will next season be the new season of hope for our sustainability where environment, social and financial co-exist rather than compete? I hope so.

MILK QUALITY

SEASON START-UP STRATEGY

Warning: The first milk you send away at the start of the season will be tested – our advice is don't bother sending anything under 600 litres!

1

There's not much milk

Don't send it! I'm serious. A minor hygiene fault might not affect a few thousand litres of milk much, but it will grade a few hundred litres. That is, there's not much dilution factor working for you. So you've got to be meticulous in both milking and cleaning practices. The best tip for avoiding first collection grades, don't send any milk until you have at least 600 litres.

2

The plant is just waking up

After two months layoff, old rubberware will have perished and dried out, joints and seals will have loosened and air leaks may have formed. You've also probably used the machine a bit without washing it properly. Do a complete machine inspection and several full-on washes before you send any milk away. Hot alkali washes recycled, followed by acid rinses.

3

Watch that vat

Check valves and fittings, do a strong hot alkali recycled wash, followed by an acid rinse. Again, allow it to dry and inspect for rainbows or patches. Scrub these areas manually. (Phone Agmax for easy vat recycle instructions)!

4

Don't take it for granted

Use your thermometer to measure the temperature of water from the hot water cylinder, 85°C is ideal. Washing in lukewarm water will certainly give you a start of season grade, particularly with the high fat early season milk.

5

Skip a day collection

Milk in your vat for two or three days is more at risk than 24 hour milking. Make sure your primary cooling system is achieving under 18°C (well under safety) If the first milking does not reach the paddle, turn off the refrigeration just before the milk freezes.

6

Early season SCC problem

Daily testing is all go, right from day one. Nearly all of these SCC grades are caused by putting the milk in the vat too soon. Observe the eight milkings withholding (heifers ten milkings), not just to avoid colostrum problems, but also because the cell counts will still be too high anyway. If the cows are not fully milked out these withholding times will not be enough. After this time only infected cows will produce high cell counts, so be vigilant for them.
